

ALPENROSE 2017 FIELD USE CONTRACT

It is understood that our leagues are guests at Alpenrose. The agreement to play on the baseball/softball diamonds is between Oregon Little League District Four and Alpenrose. As a properly chartered Little League, Oregon District Four allows permission for little leagues to use the facilities when all responsibilities are completed by the leagues asking to use the complex.

As league representative, by signing this Field Use Contract you agree that all players, managers, parents, spectators and league officials of your represented league will follow and enforce the following rules for playing at Alpenrose.

Failure to follow these rules will result in suspension of your league's privilege of playing on Alpenrose fields. District Four officials have the right and ability to suspend leagues from using Alpenrose fields until violations have been deemed rectified.

LEAGUE ACTIVITIES TO BE COMPLETED BEFORE 2017 SEASON BEGINS

- Leagues will submit to District Four by March 1, 2017: the number of rostered teams for the 2017 season at the following levels (Completed at the March President's meeting).
 - **Baseball – AAA and Majors**
 - **Softball – AAA, Majors and Juniors.**
- Leagues will send an official representative to the mandatory Alpenrose Coordinator's meeting held in March, 2017 (Virtual this year).
- Leagues will complete and submit their 2017 Alpenrose Game schedules to the District Four Alpenrose Coordinator one week before the first scheduled game of the season at Alpenrose.
- All leagues' Safety Plans (ASAP)s must be approved by Little League International and on file on the Little League International ASAP database before play at Alpenrose is allowed.
- Leagues must provide valid proof of insurance to District Four one week before the first scheduled game at Alpenrose. (Note – Alpenrose Dairy must be listed on the proof of insurance as an "other insured.")

No leagues may begin using Alpenrose fields until the above activities have been completed and verified by the Oregon Little League District Four Alpenrose Coordinator.

ALPENROSE 2017 FIELD USE RULES

- Only players/children properly rostered on a recognized Little League Baseball & Softball program team are allowed (and properly insured) to play games on these fields. No adults are allowed to play in special games (with or between Little League players, i.e., Parents vs Players) as Little League insurance does not cover losses for these injuries.
- All games scheduled and played at the Alpenrose facility will be with/between other recognized Little League teams. A full season game schedule for each team using the facility must be on file and approved by Oregon District Four before any games are played at the facility.
- Per Little League rule 1.11(a)(2), all players must have an Official Little League patch affixed to the upper left sleeve of the uniform.
- No sunflower seeds, gum or glass containers anywhere on Alpenrose property.

- No “playing” on fields unless it’s an official scheduled and approved game. All players will be recognized Little League players, properly insured under his/her Little League program insurance.
- No practicing on fields unless preparing for an official game. Pre-game warm-ups are ok.
- No bikes, skateboards, scooters or rollerblades allowed on the facility.
- No one is to sit, stand or store anything on top of Main field dugouts.
- No walking or standing on the benches or chipping paint.
- Spectators should stay at least two feet behind fences for safety.
- Outfield fence lines should be clear of spectators and items.
- No parking zones, curbs, signs and fire lanes will be enforced.
- No parking in Concession Stand area.
- Families must stay in Baseball/Softball & Picnic areas. (All other areas are off-limits. i.e. racetrack, bike track, & dairy); please monitor these areas.
- Press box, microphone and scoreboard may only be used if an adult is present. No cheering or loud play-by-play over microphone (be respectful of the Alpenrose neighbors).
- Managers/Players – Absolutely no batting or throwing practice against the cyclone fencing or bullpens
- Only the league’s President or appointed Alpenrose coordinator may contact the Alpenrose Groundkeeper to determine field playability in the event of inclement weather.
- No pets on the grounds please (service animals OK).
- Leagues may only use the fields during the designated times (below), unless prior authorization through District 4 has been approved.

REGULAR SEASON HOURS OF PLAY:

Mon-Fri: No inning may start after 9:30pm, must be off the field at 10:00pm.

Saturday: Warm-ups may begin at 8:00am, games may start at 9:00am; No inning may start after 9:30pm, must be off the field at 10:00pm

Sunday: Warm-ups may begin at 9:00am; games may start at 10:00am; No new inning may start after 6:30pm, must be off field at 7:00pm.

LEAGUE CHECKLIST FOR PLAYING GAMES ON ALPENROSE FIELDS

REGULAR SEASON PRE-GAME

- ARRANGE MAINTENANCE CREW
- ARRANGE CLEAN-UP CREW
- ARRANGE CONCESSION STAND VOLUNTEERS
- ARRANGE PRESS BOX CREW
- PUT UP FLAGS

REGULAR SEASON POST-GAME

- TRASH PICKUP
- PUT AWAY FLAGS & PRESS BOX ITEMS
- PUT ALL MAINTENANCE EQUIPMENT
- PULL BASES AND PUT THEM IN 1ST BASE DUGOUT
- PICK UP CONCESSIONS MONEY
- TURN OFF LIGHTS

I understand that failure to follow these rules will result in suspension of my league’s privilege of playing on Alpenrose fields. Additionally, I acknowledge that District Four officials have the right and ability to suspend my league from using Alpenrose fields until

violations have been deemed rectified by both the league in violation and District Four officials.

Under no circumstances will leagues “sublet” its scheduled time to any other group to use the facilities without proper permission by Oregon District Four and by Alpenrose Dairy.

As league representative, by signing below, I agree that all players, managers, parents, spectators and league officials of my represented league will follow and enforce the rules while playing at Alpenrose facility.
